ORDINANCE NO. 2010-OR-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CHARLESTOWN CITY COUNCIL INCREASING THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE COMPENSATION OF ALL CITY EMPLOYEE POSITIONS

WHEREAS, THE COMMON COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CHARLESTOWN, CLARK COUNTY, INDIANA, BEARING IN MIND THE CONTINUING EFFECTS OF INFLATION, HAS DETERMINED THAT IT IS DESIRABLE, JUST, FIT AND PROPER THAT THE PAY/COMPENSATION OF ALL CITY EMPLOYEE POSITIONS SHOULD BE INCREASED TO THE BELOW MAXIMUM WEEKLY SALARIES OR HOURLY PAY RATES: AND

WHEREAS, THERE ARE SUFFICIENT FUNDS AVAILABLE WITHIN THE CITY'S FISCAL 2011 BUDGET TO PERMIT THE INCREASES.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHARLESTOWN, CLARK COUNTY, INDIANA, THAT EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2011 THE MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE COMPENSATION OF ALL CITYEMPLOYEE POSITIONS SHALL BE INCREASED TO THE MAXIMUM WEEKLY SALARIES OR HOURLY RATES LISTED BELOW. ACTUAL 2011 SALARY INCREASES FOR ALL CURRENT OR FUTURE CITY EMPLOYEES SHALL BE SUBJECT TO APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR OR CLERK TREASURER REGARDING THEIR RESPECTIVE EMPLOYEES.


This letter comes to document the recommendation that I made to you regarding the 2011 Salary Ordinance for the City of Charlestown, Indiana.

As you are aware, it has not been possible to pass a city budget that would be expected to reflect the funds available to the city, because of the uncertainty of the revenues to be received. Therefore, the City Council could not have known how much funding was available for salaries. That being the case, I previously recommended that you not pass a salary ordinance until the council was more informed regarding the funding available for the 2011 budget.

Now that it appears that the council is prepared to pass a budget for the year 2011, I recommend that the salary ordinances be enacted immediately.
